3. Identify and describe at least two possible implications of exposure to mis-information (3 points)



- Discuss the potential consequences of mis-information, such as public distrust in media, political polarization, health risks (e.g., vaccine misinformation), or the influence on social movements and elections.
 - Provide a well-reasoned explanation of how mis-information impacts public perception and decision-making.
